What Kind Am I?

In the parable of the sower found in Matthew 13:1 - 23, Jesus mentions four kinds of people, comparing them with four kinds of soil that a gardener might find in or around his garden.

The first kind of soil, the roadside, is like the path around the edge of the garden where we walk and put our supplies. The ground is hard and the seed that falls on that ground is quickly eaten by birds.

The second kind is soil filled with rocks and stones. There the seed grows fast, because it is not deep, but when the weather gets hot, it dies, having only shallow roots.

The third kind of soil is filled with weeds. The seeds grow, they don't die, but they don't produce anything either.

The fourth ground is the good soil that produces a lot of good vegetables, grain, or fruit.

Jesus told this parable so that we could figure out which kind of soil the Word of God would find in our heart. Are we hardened against it? Do we refuse to let it root deeply into our lives? Are our lives so filled with daily activities that God has no room?

Jesus told this parable so that we would be able to see who we are and, by God's grace, make a change. What kind of soil am I?
